Seatbelt Safety – Buckle Up! It's going to be a bumpy ride.

One Small Step in Learning, One Giant Leap for Road Safety

Small children don't understand the dangers of not buckling-up. As parents and carers it is our job to teach them to buckle up!

Children of different sizes and age need different types of child car seats.

- Rearward facing – use from birth to 6 months
- Forward facing - use from 6 months to at least 4 years
- Booster seat – use when your child has outgrown the forward facing car seat to about 8-10 years old
- Adult seat belt – use when your child has outgrown the booster seat.

A few top tips to keep your family safe in the car:

- Don't start the car until everyone is buckled up correctly.
- Watch out for children trying to help you by undoing restraints for their baby brothers or sisters.
- Never allow children to share a seat belt.
- Don't hold a child on your lap whilst travelling in a vehicle – this is against the law and unsafe.
- Don't let children under 13 years old sit in the front seat.
