Safe Holiday Travelling Tips

One Small Step in Learning, One Giant Leap for Road Safety

School holiday is a great time to pile in the car and seek an adventure! Make sure you arrive safely by following these simple tips:

- Buckle up every child for every trip
- Be sure to plan to drive at times when you will be awake and alert
- Drivers need to have full vision and concentration
- Never leave kids alone in the car

Did you know that it is a law that every child have their own seat and use their own seatbelt? Children from birth to at least 7 years old need to be in their own child car seat, based on age and size.

Even for short trips don't carry children on your lap or share a seat belt. Children under the age of 13 are safest in the back seat.

Plan your trip for when the driver will be awake and fully alert. Include in your travel plans frequent stops using rest areas or other stopping places that are safe for the kids to get out of the car, too. Many places in Australia offer Driver Revive areas during the school holidays with tea and biscuits. Check with your area's road safety officer for more information.
